

Checklist 4. ... Kitchen Fitter

Tick, when sure!

- Does your fitter carry at least £1m Public Liability Insurance?
- Do you have your fitter's full contact details (full name, home address, home and mobile telephone number)?
- Have you asked for, and checked up on, references?
- Are you aware of how and when he requires payment?
- Has he (or will he bring in someone who has) the required C.O.R.G.I. and "Part P" qualifications, and do you know what these are?
- Do you know what is going to happen on each day of the installation?
- Is the work to be done crystal clear?
- Is the work you are expected to complete crystal clear?
- Has he given you an anticipated completion date?
- Has he offered a guarantee of his workmanship?
- Will he charge a penalty for returning to fit items your supplier did not deliver in time?
- Do you know what services are being replaced, and which services are being kept?
- Do you know how long this installation will take?
